Artisans, crafters and commercial vendors wishing to apply for the *ArtBeat Homegrown Art & Craft Extravaganza* must submit the application form along with payment to reserve spot to:

The *ArtBeat Homegrown Art & Craft Extravaganza* provides an indoor venue for regional artists as well as those vendors with craft items, collectibles, antiques, commercial and buy/sell items. Only one commercial vendor from each trade name or parent company will be accepted.

A limited number of vendor spaces are available; therefore, vendors will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis.

A confirmation of receipt of application, confirmation of booth space and more detailed event information will be sent to all applicants via email. Vending areas will be open for set-up from 7:00-9:30 a.m. All *ArtBeat Homegrown Art & Craft Extravaganza* booths must remain open until 9:00 p.m. All vendors must be torn-down by 10:30 p.m. Vendors will be given access to the James E. Winner Jr. Arts & Culture Center for loading and unloading. A parking area will be provided.

Check-In:

Check-in begins at 7:00 a.m. A photo ID is required at that time. Booth numbers and other materials will be distributed at check-in. Please locate your booth area as quickly and safely possible. Once you unload you must move your vehicle to the designated parking lot and then set-up at your leisure. All booths must be set-up by 9:30 a.m.

Rules:

1. A complete description of all items to be sold must accompany application.
2. The *ArtBeat Homegrown Art & Craft Extravaganza* panel reserves the right to refuse any application.
3. The *ArtBeat Homegrown Art & Craft Extravaganza* panel reserves the right to remove any work form exhibit that has been misrepresented in the application process without refund of booth fee.
4. All vendors must be present on site during the entire *ArtBeat Homegrown Art & Craft Extravaganza* designated times.
5. The WaterFire Sharon ArtBeat committee designates the placement of all vendors. Space locations cannot be guaranteed any to any vendor.
6. *ArtBeat Homegrown Art & Craft Extravaganza* vendor spaces are approximately 10'x10'. Vendors must provide their tables and/or booth display units.
7. Artists agree to allow WaterFire Sharon and *ArtBeat Homegrown Art & Craft Extravaganza* to use submitted images of work in the promotion and advertising of WaterFire Sharon.
8. Vendors are responsible for the collection and payment of PA sales tax. For more information please contact the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue Sales Tax Office.
9. Limited access to electric is available. All electrical needs must be outlined on the application form and must indicate if 110-Volt service is required. Vendors are required to bring their own extension cords.
10. By signing and remitting the *ArtBeat Homegrown Art & Craft Extravaganza* application form, the vendor agrees to abide by all *ArtBeat Homegrown Art & Craft Extravaganza* rules and guidelines. Any violation of the rules will result in removal from the Festival without refund of booth fee.
11. Acceptance to the *ArtBeat Homegrown Art & Craft Extravaganza* cannot be reassigned to another vendor.
12. All applicants expressly agree to release the *ArtBeat Homegrown Art & Craft Extravaganza*, WaterFire Sharon, the James E. Winner Jr. Arts & Culture Center and their agents from all liability for injury, damage or loss to persons or property.

Booth Fee: All booth fees are \$60

Electricity Fee: \$20

Electricity is limited and on a first-come first-serve basis. Generators are not permitted.

Checks should be made payable to WaterFire Sharon. A \$25.00 return check fee will be charged for all returned checks. Due to the limited time between notification and exhibit, no vendor booth refunds will be issued.
